

Airmanship, the Modern Pilot Model

Abstract:

Technological development has caused pilots to deal with increasingly complex IT systems that provide pilots with huge amounts of information that must be received and processed. This affects pilot situational awareness and decision-making. It was noticed that incorrect operation in these two areas is the cause of the so-called human errors, which in recent years are the cause of approximately 70 percent of aviation accidents. Due to the above, regulations regarding aviation training have been developed and implemented, which assume a new scope and level of aviation skills. The English term Airmanship means aviation skills broader than those classically understood until the 1980s..
